IMPORTANT INFORMATION AT A GLANCE

- ❖ The Prospectus and Online Application for the MBBS Degree Course for the Academic Session **2026–2027** at Shillong Medical College will be available on the official website of the Health & Family Welfare Department, <https://www.shillongmedicalcollege.co.in> , from **5th August 2026**.
- ❖ The last date for submission of the online application shall be as per the **NEET-UG Schedule 2026**.
- ❖ Out of a total of 50 MBBS seats in the Government Medical College, 15% (8 seats) shall be filled under the All-India Quota, while the remaining 85% (42 seats), inclusive of 2% reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities in accordance with Government of India norms, shall be allotted under the State Quota for the Academic Session **2026–2027**.
- ❖ The **rank list** of eligible candidates will be published on the official websites of the Shillong Medical College, <https://www.shillongmedicalcollege.co.in> after scrutiny of applications. The schedule for the first round of **counselling** and admission, as well as the commencement of the academic session, shall be as per the **NEET-UG Schedule 2026**.
- ❖ Selected candidates shall be required to execute a Bond of Agreement in the prescribed format as a condition of admission.
- ❖ All **communication** regarding admission, **counselling**, and related matters shall be made exclusively through the official websites of the Shillong Medical College (<https://www.shillongmedicalcollege.co.in>).
- ❖ Candidates shall be responsible for regularly visiting these websites from the date of application until completion of the admission process.
- ❖ The Meghalaya State Counselling Authority for Medical Education (MSCAMA) shall not be held liable for any consequences arising out of any failure on the part of candidates to comply with notices, notifications, or publications issued online.
- ❖ Eligibility for admission to the MBBS course shall be strictly based on merit determined by marks obtained in **NEET-UG 2026**, conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA), in compliance with Section 10(D) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (as amended), and in accordance with the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Reservation of seats shall be as per the **Reservation and Roster Policy** of the State of Meghalaya.
- ❖ Shillong Medical College reserves the right to amend, modify, or rescind any part of the information contained in this Prospectus pursuant to directives of competent authorities, courts of law, or regulatory bodies.

1. INTRODUCTION:

Shillong Medical College, Meghalaya, has been established with the vision of strengthening medical education and healthcare delivery in the State and the region. The College has received the Letter of Permission (LOP) from the National Medical Commission (NMC) to commence the MBBS Programme from the Academic Year 2026–27.

Committed to imparting high-quality undergraduate medical education, the institution nurtures a new generation of doctors equipped with sound knowledge, clinical skills, and ethical values. With modern infrastructure, experienced faculty, and comprehensive clinical exposure, Shillong Medical College seeks to

address the healthcare needs of Meghalaya while preparing students to become competent and compassionate medical professionals.

2. DURATION OF THE COURSE:

The duration of the course is **4 years and 6 months**, as per the Academic Calendar of the National Medical Commission (NMC), followed by **1 year of compulsory rotatory internship**.

3. COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:

The date of commencement of the Course will be notified for the current academic year 2026-27 as per NEET-UG-2026 Schedule.

4. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

The medium of instruction shall be English only.

5. AFFILIATION:

The course is recognized by the National Medical Commission (NMC) and affiliated with the North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU), Shillong.

7. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

(a) The Prospectus may be obtained from the Director, Shillong Medical College, Shillong–793001, on payment of Rs. 500.00 for the State Quota and Rs. 500.00 for the All-India Quota (AIQ), or downloaded free of cost from meghealth.gov.in or <https://shillongmedicalcollege.co.in/admissions>.

(b) Candidates shall ensure that the duly filled-in application form, together with the relevant enclosures, reaches the Director's Office within the date and time specified.

(c) All Demand Drafts should be drawn in favour of "The Shillong Medical College Management Society", payable at Shillong, with the following bank details: Bank: IDBI Bank, A/C No.: 0158104000077969, IFSC Code: IBKL0000158.

(d) For reservation under the Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) category, candidates may refer to the National Medical Commission Guidelines (NMCG) and the NEET UG-2026 Information Bulletin issued by the National Testing Agency, particularly Clause 6.2.4 and Clause 6.7.

8. ELIGIBILITY OF CANDIDATES FOR THE 'STATE QUOTA SEATS':

i. The candidate must belong to a Scheduled Tribe (ST), Scheduled Caste (SC), or Other Scheduled Tribe (OST) community of Meghalaya, holding a valid certificate issued by the competent authority in the State, and be a permanent resident of Meghalaya possessing a Permanent Residential Certificate (PRC) issued in accordance with Government of Meghalaya Political Department Letter No. POL.97/74/174 dated 10th July 1983.

ii. Academic Eligibility Criteria as per NEET Bulletin 2026:

Candidates shall be eligible for admission to the MBBS Course only if they have passed the 2nd Pre-University Course / Higher Secondary (10+2) / Equivalent Examination with English as one of the subjects and have obtained a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Biotechnology taken together. In the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Tribe (ST), Scheduled Caste (SC), and Other Scheduled Tribe (OST) categories of Meghalaya, the minimum aggregate marks required shall be 40% in the aforesaid subjects. Further, all candidates must have appeared in the UG-NEET 2026 Examination and have been declared qualified therein, with inter se merit determined strictly on the basis of the All-India Rank (AIR) in UG-NEET 2026, subject to fulfilment of all other eligibility conditions stipulated in the UG-NEET 2026 Information Bulletin.

iii. Other Eligibility Criteria:

The age of the candidate shall not be below 17 years as on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.

The candidate should be medically fit and certified by a Medical Board constituted by the Health & Family Welfare Department, Meghalaya.

9. ELIGIBILITY OF CANDIDATES FOR THE 'ALL INDIA QUOTA SEATS':

Eligibility for AIQ seats shall be as per the NEET-UG 2026 Information Bulletin.

10. PROCESS OF APPLICATION:

Candidates may visit the Institute's website to apply online for the MBBS Undergraduate Course for the Session 2026–2027 at meghealth.gov.in.

The last date for submission of the Online Application shall be as per the NEET-UG Schedule 2026.

Steps on how to fill the Online Application Form:

i) Registration: Click on the link provided on the official website <https://www.shillongmedicalcollege.co.in/notifications> for online application to the MBBS Session 2026–2027. On clicking the link, the application portal shall open.

a. Students need to register on this portal.

b. Upon successful registration, candidates shall use their registered email ID (as the Login ID) and the password set during registration to log in to the portal and access the application form.

ii) Application Form:

a. The candidate shall correctly fill in the following details on the portal:

- Name of Student: As per the Class XII Admit Card
- Type of Course: MBBS
- Year: 1st
- Hostel Facility: Yes/No (as applicable)

b. Upon successful submission of the application, a system-generated acknowledgement shall be issued by the portal.

c. Each candidate shall retain a copy of the acknowledgement as proof of application for all future correspondence.

d. The Application Processing Fee, once paid, shall be non-refundable under any circumstances.

e. All enclosures are to be uploaded, and candidates shall then click on "Save Annexure" (maximum file size for each enclosure to be uploaded is 2 MB):

Permanent Residential Certificate: Valid for the year 2026, issued by the competent authority (i.e., the District Commissioner of the State or any Government-authorized official), certifying that he/she is a permanent resident of Meghalaya.

Age Proof: High School Certificate / Secondary School Certificate / Admit Card of the Class X or Class XII Examination issued by the Board/University showing the date of birth, or a Birth Certificate issued by the competent Government authority.

Certificates: Pass Certificate / Provisional Pass Certificate where the candidate has already cleared the qualifying examination.

Mark Sheets: Clearly readable mark sheets of the 10+2 Examination showing the marks secured by the applicant.

NEET-UG 2026 score Card Containing the All India Rank and percentile of marks obtained in NEET-UG 2026.

f. After saving the enclosures, candidates may preview the form and finally click on "Submit".

g. After submission of the form, the student shall be able to download the acknowledgement slip. He/she shall also receive an email confirming the successful submission of the form.

Important Note:

i. Incomplete Online Applications shall be summarily rejected, and no correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.

ii. If the ineligibility of a candidate is detected at any stage, either before or after admission, his/her candidature shall be summarily rejected.

iii. In the event that any candidate is found to have furnished false information or certificates, or is found to have withheld or concealed any material information in his/her application, he/she shall be debarred from admission.

11. METHOD OF SELECTION:

i. Selection for admission to the 42 (forty-two) seats shall be based on the NEET-UG 2026 qualified score and percentile obtained by the candidate.

ii. Candidates who have not qualified in NEET-UG 2026 shall not be considered for admission to the Institute, and their names shall not be included in the merit list.

iii. A merit list of all eligible candidates shall be prepared on the basis of the NEET-UG 2026 All India Rank (AIR).

12. COUNSELLING:

i. The list of candidates called for counselling shall be published on the official websites: meghealth.gov.in and <https://www.shillongmedicalcollege.co.in>

ii. It shall be the responsibility of the candidate to ascertain the date of counselling from the Institute website. No individual call letter shall be issued.

iii. Candidates shortlisted for counselling and selected for admission shall be required to undergo a medical examination at the Institute on the notified date at their own expense.

iv. At the time of counselling, candidates shall appear in person and produce the original copies of the following documents:

a) Permanent Residential Certificate valid for the year 2026, issued by the competent authority (i.e., the District Commissioner of the State or any Government-authorized official), certifying that he/she is a permanent resident of Meghalaya in accordance with Political Department Letter No. POL.97/74/174 dated 10th July 1983.

b) Age Proof: High School Certificate / Secondary School Certificate / Admit Card of the Class X or Class XII Examination issued by the Board/University showing the date of birth, or a Birth Certificate issued by the competent Government authority.

c) Certificates: Pass Certificate / Provisional Pass Certificate and Character and Conduct Certificate.

d) Mark Sheets: Clearly readable mark sheets of the 10+2 Examination showing the marks secured by the applicants.

Admission shall not be finalized unless the candidates produce all the original documents.

v) There shall be no allocation of marks for counselling. Counselling shall be conducted strictly on the basis of merit determined by the NEET-UG 2026 score and percentile.

vi) Candidates found medically fit shall be required to pay the admission fee in full.

vii) To fill vacancies arising due to the non-appearance of selected candidates, a sufficient number of candidates from the waiting list shall also be called for the second round of counselling. Such candidates shall be required to appear for the second and/or third round of counselling on the notified date at their own expense.

viii) Candidates who fail to attend the counselling and/or medical examination on the notified date shall forfeit their claim for admission as well as their position on the waiting list.

ix) Candidates who are granted admission must join their classes on the notified date of commencement of the academic session. The selection/admission of a candidate is liable to be cancelled if he/she fails to report for classes on the stipulated date without prior permission.

x) Out of the 50 MBBS seats in Shillong Medical College, 8 (eight) seats, constituting 15% of the total intake capacity, shall be allocated to the All-India Quota in accordance with the directives of the Government of India.

13. HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION:

i) Hostel accommodation will be provided.

ii) Applications for hostel accommodation shall be submitted in the prescribed format and shall contain an undertaking from the parent or guardian regarding the good conduct and behaviour of the candidate during his/her stay in the hostel. Hostel accommodation shall be allotted by the Hostel Warden.

14. LIBRARY:

The Institute Library is well stocked with important medical books and journals. Other facilities include photocopying and internet access. Books and periodicals may be borrowed by bona fide members for a specified period.

15. BOND:

All selected candidates shall execute a bond as per the "Mandatory Medical Public Service Policy for Medical Students (UG/PG) Pursuing Academic Curriculum under State Government Sponsorship/In-Service Quota Seats", notified vide No. Health/231/2024/6 dated 28th February 2025, on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 50.00 (Rupees Fifty Only) at the time of admission. If any candidate leaves the course without completing it, he/she shall be required to pay/deposit bond money of Rs. 30,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Lakhs Only).

17. LEGAL JURISDICTION

i) All disputes pertaining to the conduct of the allotment of seats under the State Quota, and cases of impersonation, if any, detected during the admission process, shall fall within the jurisdiction of the Examination Centres only. The Director, Shillong Medical College, shall be the legal person in whose name Shillong Medical College may sue or be sued.

ii) The dispute arising with regard to the counselling and admission process after the NEET Examination shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble High Court of Meghalaya, Shillong.

18. MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Candidates selected for admission shall be required to undergo a medical examination by a Medical Board consisting of faculty members of the Institute. If, in the opinion of the Medical Board, a candidate is found medically unfit, he/she shall not be admitted.

19. ANTI-RAGGING MEASURES

As per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, ragging in any form, within or outside the campus, is strictly prohibited, and the authorities are determined not to permit any form of ragging. Any person who directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or instigates ragging within or outside Shillong Medical College shall have an FIR lodged against him/her and shall be liable for suspension or rustication from the Institute and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only). In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past, or if it is subsequently discovered that he/she has engaged in ragging, admission may be refused or he/she may be expelled from the Institute. The punishment may also include suspension from attending classes, withholding or withdrawal of fellowships, scholarships, and other financial benefits, or withholding the results.

20. CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- i. All powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action shall be vested in the Director.
- ii. The Director may delegate such powers, as he/she deems appropriate, to the Dean or to such other persons as he/she may specify on his/her behalf.
- iii. Without prejudice to the generality of the power to enforce discipline under the Rules, the following shall constitute acts of gross indiscipline:
 - a) Physical assault or threat to use physical force against any member of the teaching or non-teaching staff of any Department/Centre of Shillong Medical College or any other person within the premises.
 - b) Carrying, use, or threat of use of any weapon.
 - c) Violation of the status, dignity, and honour of students belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes.
 - d) Any practice, whether verbal or otherwise, derogatory to women.
 - e) Any attempt at bribing or corruption in any manner.
 - f) Willful destruction of institutional property.
 - g) Creating ill-will or intolerance on religious or communal grounds.
 - h) Causing disruption in any manner in the functioning of Shillong Medical College, Shillong.
- iv. In any case of ragging, the Director may, in exercise of his/her powers as per the aforesaid order on ragging, direct that any student or students:
 - a) be expelled
 - b) be, for a stated period, denied admission to a course or courses of study in Shillong Medical College
 - c) be fined a sum of rupees as may be specified
 - d) be debarred from taking any examination(s) for one or more semesters
 - e) have their results in the examination(s) in which he/she or they have appeared withheld or cancelled
 - f) be prohibited from appearing in or completing any examination due to use of unfair means such as copying, carrying notes, mobile phones, or any other electronic gadgets inside the examination hall.
- v. At the time of admission, every student shall be required to sign a declaration that, on admission, he/she submits himself/herself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Director and other authorities of Shillong Medical College who may be vested with the authority to exercise discipline under the Acts, Statutes, Rules, and regulations framed there under by the competent authorities of Shillong Medical College.

vi. Anti-Sexual Harassment Monitoring Committee:

A statutory committee comprising members from the teaching and non-teaching staff as well as students **looks into matters related to sexual harassment of students and staff in the college.** Any person aggrieved in this matter may fearlessly approach the committee for a fair hearing and **redressal.**

vii. Unauthorized Absence of Students:

Unauthorized absence of students shall be informed to the students concerned and also to their parents or local guardians. At least 3 reminders shall be issued with a gap of 10 days by the Academic Section to these students. Thereafter, the action of cancellation of the registration of the concerned student shall be decided by the Dean/Director, Shillong Medical College.

21. COMMUNICATION:

All communications with candidates shall be made exclusively through the official websites of the Health & Family Welfare Department (<https://meghealth.gov.in/>) and Shillong Medical College (<https://www.shillongmedicalcollege.co.in>). The rank list shall be published only on the said websites.

The decision of the Director, Shillong Medical College shall be final and binding in this regard.

Candidates applying for admission to the MBBS Degree Course for the Academic Session 2026–2027 shall be deemed to have read and accepted all provisions of this Prospectus. By submitting the application, candidates expressly agree to abide by all terms and conditions contained herein and shall have no right to challenge any clause of the Prospectus.
