- ❖ The Prospectus and Online Application for the MBBS Degree Course for the Academic Session 2025–2026 at Shillong Medical College will be available on the official websites of the Health & Family Welfare Department https://meghealth.gov.in/ from 5th September, 2025.
- ❖ The last date for submission of the online application shall be as per NEET-UG Schedule 2025.
- Out of a total of 50 MBBS seats in the Government Medical College, 15% (8 seats) shall be filled under the All-India Quota, while the remaining 85% (42 seats), inclusive of 2% reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities in accordance with Government of India norms, shall be allotted under the State Quota for the Academic Session 2025–2026.
- ❖ The Rank list of eligible candidates will be published on the official websites of the Health & Family Welfare Department https://meghealth.gov.in/ and Shillong Medical College https://smcshillong.ac.in/ after scrutiny of applications. The schedule for the first round of counseling and admission, as well as the commencement of the academic session, shall be as per NEET-UG Schedule 2025.
- Selected candidates shall be required to execute a Bond of Agreement in the prescribed format as a condition of admission.
- All communication regarding admission, counseling, and related matters shall be made exclusively through the official websites of the Health & Family Welfare Department: https://meghealth.gov.in/ and Shillong Medical College: https://smcshillong.ac.in/.
- Candidates shall be responsible for regularly visiting these websites from the date of application until completion of the admission process.
- The Meghalaya State Counselling Authority for Medical Education (MSCAMA) shall not be held liable for any consequences arising out of failure on the part of candidates to follow notices, notifications, or publications issued online.
- Eligibility for admission to the MBBS course shall be strictly based on merit determined by marks obtained in NEET-UG 2025 conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA), in compliance with Section 10 (D) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (as amended), and in accordance with orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Reservation of seats shall be as per Reservation & Roster policy of the State of Meghalaya.
- Shillong Medical College reserves the right to amend, modify, or rescind any part of the information contained in this Prospectus pursuant to directives of competent authorities, courts of law, or regulatory bodies.
- This document shall not be cited or treated as a legal sanction for any claim. 1. INTRODUCTION:

Shillong Medical College, Meghalaya, has been established with the vision of strengthening medical education and healthcare delivery in the state and the region. The College has received the Letter of Permission (LOP) from the National Medical Commission (NMC) to commence the MBBS programme from the Academic Year 2025–26.

Committed to imparting high-quality undergraduate medical education, the institution nurtures a new generation of doctors equipped with sound knowledge, clinical skills, and ethical values. With modern infrastructure, experienced faculty, and comprehensive clinical exposure, Shillong Medical College seeks to address the healthcare needs of Meghalaya while preparing students to become competent and compassionate medical professionals.

2. DURATION OF THE COURSE:

The duration of course is 4 years and 6 months as per the Academic calendar of National Medical Commission (NMC), followed by 1 year compulsory rotatory internship.

3. COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:

The date of commencement of the Course will be notified for the current academic year 2025-26 as per NEET-UG-2025 Schedule.

4. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

The Medium of Instruction shall be English only.

5. AFFILATION:

The course is recognized by National Medical Commission (NMC) and affiliated to the North Eastern Hill University (NEHU), Shillong.

7. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS: -

- (a) Prospectus may be obtained on payment of Rs.500.00 for State Quota and AIQ Rs.500.00 from the Directorate of Health Services Medical Education & Research (DME), Shillong -793001 or downloaded free of cost from meghealth.gov.in or smcshillong.ac.in
- (b) The candidates shall ensure that the filled-in application form with the relevant enclosures should reach the DMER, within the date and time specified.

8. ELIGIBILITY OF CANDIDATES FOR THE 'STATE QUOTA SEATS':

i. The candidate must be from Scheduled Tribe or Scheduled Caste (including Other Scheduled Tribes and SC) of Meghalaya, holding a valid certificate issued by the competent authority in the State,

and

a permanent resident of Meghalaya possessing a Permanent Residential Certificate (PRC) issued in accordance with Government of Meghalaya Political Department Letter No. POL.97/74/174 dated 10th July 1983.

ii. Academic Eligibility Criteria as per NEET Bulletin 2025:

Candidates shall be eligible for admission to the MBBS Course only if they have passed the 2nd Pre-University Course / Higher Secondary (10+2) / Equivalent Examination with English as one of the subjects and have obtained a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Bio-technology taken together. In the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Tribe (ST), Scheduled Caste (SC), and Other Scheduled Tribe (OST) categories of Meghalaya, the minimum aggregate marks required shall be 40% in the aforesaid subjects. Further, all candidates must have appeared in the UG-NEET 2025 Examination and have been declared as qualified therein, with inter se merit determined strictly on the basis of the All-India Rank (AIR) in UG-NEET 2025, subject to fulfillment of all other eligibility conditions stipulated in the UG-NEET 2025 Information Bulletin.

iii. Other eligibility criteria:

The age of the candidate shall not be below 17 years on the 31st December of the year in which the admission shall be sought for.

The candidate should be medically fit and to be certified by a medical board constituted by the Health & Family Welfare Department, Meghalaya.

9. ELIGIBILITY OF CANDIDATES FOR THE 'ALL INDIA QUOTA SEATS':

Eligibility for AIQ seats will be as per NEET-UG Bulletin 2025.

10. PROCESS OF APPLICATION:

Candidates may visit the Institute's website to apply Online for MBBS Under Graduate Course Session 2025-2026 at meghealth.gov.in.

The Last date for submission of Online Application shall be as per NEET-UG Schedule 2025.

Steps on how to fill the Online application form: -

- i) Registration: Click on the Link provided in the official website https://smcshillong.ac.in/ for online application for MBBS Session 2025-2026. On clicking the link, the following site will be opened.
 - a. Students need to register in this portal.
 - b. Upon successful registration, candidates shall use their registered email ID (as the login ID) and the password set during registration to log in to the portal and access the application form.
- ii) Application FORM:
 - a. The candidate shall correctly fill in the following details on the portal:
 - Name of Student: As per the Class 12th Admit Card
 - Type of Course: MBBS
 - Year: 1st

- b. Upon successful application, a system-generated acknowledgement shall be issued by the portal.
- c. Each candidate shall retain a copy of the acknowledgement as proof of application for all future correspondence.
- d. The Application Processing Fee, once paid, shall be non-refundable under any circumstances.
- e. All enclosures are to be uploaded and then click on save annexure (Max size for enclosure to be uploaded is 2 mb):

Permanent Residential Certificate valid for the year 2025, from the competent authority (i.e. District Commissioner of the state or any Government authorized Official) certifying that he/she is Permanent resident of either of Meghalaya.

Age proof: High School Certificate / Secondary School Certificate / Admit Card of 10th or 10+2 Exams issued by the Board / University showing the date of birth / Birth Certificate of the applicant issued by the competent Government authority.

Certificates: Pass Certificate / Provisional Pass Certificate where the candidate has already cleared the qualifying examination.

Mark Sheets: Clearly readable mark sheet of the 10+2 examination showing the marks secured by the applicants.

NEET-UG 2025 Score Card containing the all-India Rank and percentile of marks obtained in NEET-UG 2025.

- f. After saving the enclosures, you can preview the form and finally click on Submit.
- g. After the form submission student will be able to download the acknowledgement slip. He/She will also receive an email confirming the form submission.

Important Note:

- i. Incomplete Online Application will be summarily rejected and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- ii. If ineligibility of a candidate is detected at any stage, before or after the admission, his/her candidature will be summarily rejected.
- iii. In case any candidate is found to have furnished false information or certificate etc. or is found to have withheld or concealed any material information in his/her application, he/she will be debarred from admission.

11. METHOD OF SELECTION:

- i) Selection for admission to the 42 (forty-two) seats shall be based on the NEET UG -2025 qualified SCORE and percentile of marks calculated.
- ii) Candidates not qualified in the NEET-UG 2025 will not be considered for admission to the Institute and their names will not be included in the merit list.
- iii) A merit list of all the candidates will be prepared on the basis on the NEET-UG 2025 All India Rank.

12. COUNSELING:

- i) List of candidates called for counselling will be published in the official website: meghealth.gov.in and smcshillong.ac.in
- ii) It is the responsibility of the candidate to find out the date of counselling from Institute Website, no individual call letter will be sent.
- iii) Candidates listed for counselling and selected for admission shall have to attend and medical examination at the Institute at their own cost on the notified date.
- iv) At the time of counselling, candidates will have to attend in person and produce the original of the following documents
 - a) Permanent Residential Certificate valid for the year 2025, from the competent authority (i.e. District Commissioner of the state or any Government authorized Official) proving that he/she is Permanent resident of Meghalaya as per 'Political Department Letter no. POL.97/74/174 dated 10th July 1983'.
 - b) Age Proof: High School Certificate / Secondary School Certificate / Admit Card of 10th or 10+ 2 Exams issued by the Board / University showing the date of birth / Birth Certificate of the applicant issued by the competent Government authority.

- c) Certificates: Pass Certificate / Provisional Pass Certificate. Character and Conduct Certificate.
- d) Mark Sheets: Clearly readable mark sheet of the 10+2 examination showing the marks secured by the applicants.

Admission will not be finalized unless the candidates produce all the original documents.

- v) There will be no allocation of marks for the counselling. Counselling will be conducted strictly on the basis of merit in the NEET UG -2025 score and percentile.
- vi) Candidates found medically fit are required to pay the admission fee in full.
- vii) To fill vacancies arising due to failure of appearance by the selected candidates, sufficient number of candidates from the waiting list will also be called for 2nd counselling. Such candidates will have to appear for the 2nd and/or 3rd counselling on the notified date at their own cost.
- viii) Candidates who fail to attend counselling/medical examination on the notified date shall forfeit their claim for admission and placement in the waiting list.
- ix) Candidates who have been admitted must join their classes on the date of commencement of the classes. The Selection/Admission is liable to be cancelled if the selected candidate does not report to join the class on the stipulated date without prior permission.
- x) Out of the 50 MBBS seats in Shillong Medical College, 8 (eight) seats, being 15% of the total intake capacity, shall stand allocated to the All-India Quota in accordance with the directives of the Government of India.

13. HOSTEL ACCOMODATION:

- i) Hostel accommodation will be provided.
- ii) Application for accommodation in the hostels should be in the prescribed format containing the assurance by the parents or guardian for the good conduct and behavior of the candidate during his/her stay in the hostel. Admission to hostel will be given allotted by the Hostel Warden.

14. LIBRARY:

The Institute Library is well stocked with all important medical books and journals. Other facilities include photocopying and internet. Books and periodicals are loaned to bona fide members for a specific period of time.

15. BOND:

All the selected candidates have to execute a bond as per 'Mandatory Medical Public Service Policy' for Medical Students (UG/PG) Pursuing Academic Curriculum Under State Government Sponsorship/In-Service Quota Seats" notified vide No. Health/231/2024/6 dated 28th February 2025 on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 50.00 (Rupees Fifty Only) at the time of admission. If any candidate leaves the course without completion shall have to pay/deposit bond money of Rs. 30, 000, 00/- (Rupees Thirty Lakhs) only.

17. LEGAL JURISDICTION:

- i) All disputes pertaining to the conduct of the allotment of seats for state quota and impersonation, if any detected shall fall within the jurisdiction of the Examination Centres only. The Director, Shillong Medical College shall be the legal person in whose name Shillong Medical College may sue or may be sued.
- ii) The disputes, if any with regard to counselling and admission process after the NEET exam, etc. will be subject to the legal Jurisdiction at Hon'ble High Court of Meghalaya, Shillong.

18. MEDICAL EXAMINATION:

The candidates selected for the admission will have to undergo medical examination by a medical Board consisting of Faculty members of the Institute. If in the assessment of the Medical Board, a candidate is found medically unfit, he/she will not be admitted.

19. ANTIRAGGING MEASURES:

As per direction of the Honorable Supreme Court of India, the Government has banned ragging completely in any form inside and outside the campus and authorities are determined not to allow any form of ragging. Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or instigates ragging within or outside Shillong Medical College shall have an FIR lodged against him/her and he/she will be suspended or rusticated from the Institute and shall also be liable to be fined which may extend to Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) only. In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/she has indulged in ragging, admission can be refused or he/she shall be expelled from the Institute. The punishment may also include suspension from attending the classes, withholding/ withdrawing fellowship/ scholarship and other financial benefits or withholding the result.

20. CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS:

- All powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action are vested in the Director.
- ii. The Director may delegate all such powers, as he/she deems proper to the Dean and to such other persons as he/she may specify on his/her behalf.
- iii. Without prejudice to the generality of power to enforce discipline under the Rules. The following shall amount to acts of gross indiscipline; -

- a) Physical assault or threat to use physical force against any member of the teaching or non-teaching staff of any Department/ Centre of Shillong Medical College or any other persons within the premises.
- b) Carrying, use or threat of use of any weapon.
- c) Violation of the status, dignity and honor of students belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Castes.
- d) Any practice, whether verbal or otherwise, derogatory to women.
- e) Any attempt at bribing or corruption in any manner.
- f) Willful destruction of institutional property.
- g) Creating ill-will or intolerance on religious or communal grounds.
- h) Causing disruption in any manner of the functioning of the Shillong Medical College, Shillong.
- iv. In any case of ragging the Director may in exercise of his/her powers as per the aforesaid order on ragging direct that any student or students.
 - a) Be expelled.
 - b) Be, for a stated period: be not for a stated period, admitted to a course or courses of study in Shillong Medical College
 - c) Be fined with a sum of rupees that may be specified.
 - d) Be debarred from taking any examination(s) for one or more semesters.
 - e) Withhold the result of the student(s) concerned in the Examination(s) in which he /she or they have appeared be cancelled.
 - f) Be prohibited for appearing or completing any examination for any unfair means like copying taking notes, mobiles or any other electronic gadgets inside the examination halls.
- v. At the time of admission, every student shall be required to sign a declaration that on admission he/ she submits himself/herself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Director and several authorities of Shillong Medical College who may be vested with the authority to exercise discipline under the Acts, the Statues, the Rules and the rules that have been framed there under by competent authorities of Shillong Medical College.

vi. Anti Sexual Harassment Monitoring Committee:

A statutory committee, comprising of members from the teaching and non-teaching staff as well as students looks into matters related to sexual harassment of students and staff in the college. Any person aggrieved in this matter may fearlessly approach the committee for a fair and concerned hearing and redressed.

iii) Unauthorized absence of students:

Unauthorized absence of students will be informed to the Students and also Parents or Local Guardians. At least 3 reminders will be issued with a gap of 10 days by the Academic Section to these students. Thereafter the action of cancellation of the registration of the concerned student will be decided by the Dean/Director, Shillong Medical College.

21. COMMUNICATION:

All communication with candidates shall be made exclusively through the official websites of the Health & Family Welfare Department (https://meghealth.gov.in/) and Shillong Medical College (https://smcshillong.ac.in/). The rank list shall be published only on the said websites.

The decision of the Director of Health Services (Medical Education & Research) shall be final and binding in this regard.

Candidates applying for admission to the MBBS Degree Course for the academic session 2025–2026 shall be deemed to have read and accepted all provisions of this Prospectus. By submitting the application, candidates expressly agree to abide by all terms and conditions contained herein and shall have no right to challenge any clause of the Prospectus.
